Clue	Replaces a full stop to show a
Example	What is you name?
Answer	Question Mark
Clue	Used to separate lists or to show
Example	I will buy Carrots, tomatoes and
Answer	Comma
Clue	Replaces a full stop to give a
Example	Help me!
Answer	Exclamation Mark

Clue	Shows part of the text that is spoken
Example	"Who are you?" he asked
Answer	Speech Marks
Clue	Used to show a noun owning something
Example	This is David's jumper
Answer	Possessive Apostrophe
Clue	Used to show that a letter is removed to shorten the words
Example	I don't think I'll go with you
Answer	Contractive Apostrophe
Clue	Shows missing or unfinished words
Example	I'm really scared of the ...
Answer	Ellipsis

Clue	Used to show start of a list
Example	Shopping list: pineapple, apples, bananas and lemons
Answer	Colon

Clue	Sometimes used instead of a comma, used around text that gives more detail about something
Example	He finally finished his work (after taking 30 minutes)
Answer	Brackets

Clue	Can be used instead of a connective
Example	I have finished my work; now I can play
Answer	Semicolon



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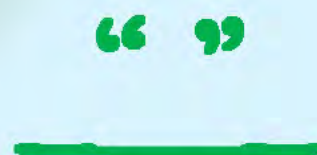
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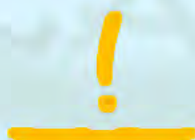
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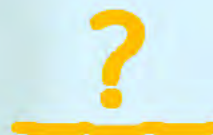
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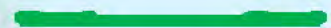
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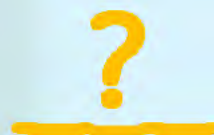
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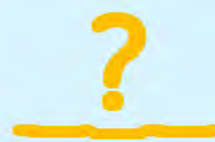
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
